Note: 0.9 miles of Stoney Hill Road and Hamilton Road are on an unpaved surface.

**Scenic Route North to Dells of the Eau Claire County Park, Marathon County:**  
From intersection of Cty I and Hemlock Rd in Portage County, go west on Hemlock Rd., north on Woodland Road, west on County Line Drive, then north on Cty Y passing thru Shantytown and along Wadley Lake and continuing north along the Plover River valley. Cty Y will intersect with HWY 29 at Hatley where the **Mountain Bay State Trail** can also be accessed. Continue north on Cty Y to the Park entrance. (Cty Y will join with Cty Z and go west for one mile and then turn north again.)  
Approximate Trip Length is 31.7 miles.
